

Eligibility

Only legal residents of the United States who are 18 years of age or older as of April 1, 2008 are eligible to enter. Participation in the drawing is void where prohibited by law. Officers of the Lake Forest High School Foundation, an Illinois not-for-profit organization, members of their immediate households, and owners or employees of Jewels of Lake Forest are ineligible to enter the drawing.

Thank you for your interest in the Lake Forest High School Foundation “Jewel of a School” Drawing. By entering this drawing you are stating that you have read the drawing rules and accept them. If you have any questions about the rules below please contact us and we will do our best to answer all of your questions. The rules are:

- Winner need not be present to win.
- Winner will be randomly selected by a Lake Forest High School administrator on Friday, May 9, 2008.
- Winner will be notified by phone and in writing by Certified Mail. Winner’s name will also be made available at the Lake Forest High School Foundation website www.lfhsfoundation.org. Winner will be required to provide proof of identification acceptable to Lake Forest High School Foundation and/or Jewels of Lake Forest.
- In the event of a winning entry having more than one name, the prize will be awarded to the first name listed on the entry.
- If the winner does not claim his/her prize by May 31, 2008, and is unable to be located, a second winner will be drawn.
- Acceptance of the prize constitutes winner’s permission for the Lake Forest High School Foundation and/or Jewels of Lake Forest to use winner’s name for publicity purposes without further compensation.
- If a credit card charge for a drawing chance is rejected or denied or a personal check is returned for non-sufficient funds (with processing fees of \$25.00) and the responsible party does not provide cash payment *no later than 5 days prior to* drawing, the entry is null and void.
